

The future of CHTA

An important message to all CHTA members from Chairman Roger Haw



I hope you are all enjoying a good start to 2024, a year that will be one of great change for CHTA. The ultimate survival of our Association will depend upon our addressing the current trends in our industry sector.

To summarise the present situation:

- In May we will lose the services of our valued Secretary Alan J Hick who has put off his retirement for a long time and helped us get through the Covid pandemic.
- Membership is on the decline as more and more members decide to shut up shop. (The number of member sites has reduced from 52, pre-Covid, to 38 now).
- As I warned at last year's AGM, the current fee structure will produce an income well below that required to continue the Association in its present form.

 The current state of the finances is such that we could not expect to survive for more than two years if we do not change.

Your Management Committee, pictured below, has considered the problems and will present you with proposals, before the forthcoming AGM, to control the situation.

In doing so, it has been decided that maintenance of the publication of *Hotline*, the Benchmarking function and the Market Movements survey are all retentions which the membership would like to see. In addition to this, our representation to Government, over various items affecting the industry, must be maintained in alliance with SEA.

In order to continue, we have to increase the membership. It is obvious, under current economic circumstances, that no one is going to start a new heat treatment company. However, the membership can be increased by allowing a wider range of enterprises to join the Association.

The Management Committee is proposing that any organisation or individual with an interest in heat treatment should be allowed to join; this would include inhouse heat treatment operations, acad-

emic institutions and suppliers to the industry. In adopting such changes, a renaming will be necessary. It is proposed that the name of the Association becomes "The Heat Treatment Association".

Many alterations for the continuance of the administration (following the Secretary's retirement) are already being addressed and put in place.

The changes in respect of qualification for membership will require significant alterations to CHTA's Articles of Association and, in due course, you'll be asked to vote in a special resolution to validate them.

A lot of work has already been done and I strongly urge you to vote in favour of the changes when presented with the opportunity. In the meantime, if anyone has any queries, please do not hesitate to contact me at roger@flamehardeners.co.uk

Paradise lost?

Dan Herring, of The HERRING GROUP, Inc., USA, reflects on in-house training.

All my years spent in the heat treatment industry have taught me two invaluable lessons. First, ours is truly an empirical science, a science whose secrets reveal themselves by doing and (in large measure) through trial and error. Second, common sense triumphs when all else fails; there is no substitute for practical experience.

The key question then becomes: how does a person entering the workforce in our industry gain the knowledge necessary to become a world-class heat treater? This is especially relevant today given the performance demands placed on products and the rapidly evolving nature of technology.

In "the good old days" - that is, in "Paradise" - skills were acquired through mentoring over time. More experienced personnel imparted hard-earned wisdom to their apprentices, usually in well-metered doses as situations arose that required a new lesson be taught or insights gained. Nowhere was this more fitting than in the heat treat shop.

But what about today? The pressure on

engineering and manufacturing to produce has fuelled the need for instant answers, achieved through Internet searches and superficial investigations. There is often no time, or tolerance, for failure.

One of my early mentors often lamented that "greed and avarice will be the Achilles heel of young people, too few of you want to work hard - and learning any skill is hard work!"

However, there are many hard-working, young, highly-intelligent and eager-to-learn individuals entering today's workforce. They tend to fall into two categories - those with excellent theoretical skills who lack practical experience and those with practical skills who lack a basic understanding of the interaction between the equipment, process and outcome.

The "secret" to heat treating is the control of process- and equipment-related variability. But the playing field is constantly in flux - as soon as we believe we have the process or equipment under control, something changes: a leak develops, quench media degrade, humidity in the room changes - the list goes on and on.

How, then, do we teach the next generation to meet these challenges? Equally important, how do we teach them to retain them in our industry? Without proper incentive, motivation, and guidance, they will either choose a more rewarding path or seek a more "glamorous" industry.

Teamwork is the key to success in today's heat treat shop. And networking is the key to the acquisition of knowledge. Understand where the true sources of information

lie and seek them out. Talk to people and understand not only what they've learned but how they learned it. Motivate others to share what they know. And share what you know. Tap into the resources available to you, especially from more experienced people, or those recently retired from the industry.

Don't be afraid to try or to fail. If you do, pick yourself up, dust yourself off, take a moment to say, "That hurt," and go out and fail again and again until you succeed.

Finally, think before you act, and act only after having thought through both your actions and their consequences. Constantly ask yourself, "Why is there never enough time to do something right, but always enough time to do it over (and over) again?"

These are your keys to success and a long, rewarding career.

SECOND HIP PRESS ORDERED

Bringing forward plans by two years, Wallwork Group have signed for a second hot isostatic press from Quintus Technologies. This follows hot on the heels of opening their £10million Wallwork HIP Centre, with Quintus completing the commissioning of the first HIP in the third quarter of 2023.

"Demand from customers for processing components in our first hot isostatic press has been astonishing. It is prudent to bring forward planned investment for the next HIP, knowing it will take most of 2024 to build and install. We hope to have it up and running by early 2025. Deciding to prepare pits for expansion during the first installation has proved right," explained Group Director, Simeon Collins.

"We expected strong demand from UK castings, 3D printing, powder fabrication, and near-net-shape manufacturers, especially as the UK is currently under-served with hot isostatic pressing capacity. 


